Welcome, Visitors!

Visitor Policy: Effective June 13, 2023

- Visiting hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. 2 asymptomatic visitors are allowed at a time for all areas. Visitors may leave and re-enter the hospital during the specified visiting hours.
- Visitors are required to wear a face mask in all patient care areas, regardless of their vaccination status. Visitors not wearing a face mask will be issued one. If visitors refuse to don a face mask, they will be asked to leave the facility.
- Visitors must check-in with security each time they enter the building.
- Visitors are allowed to bring outside food. Floral arrangements may be brought to any patient care area with the exception of critical care or where neutropenic patients receive care.

UNIT-SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- Inpatient Units: Children 14 years of age and older can visit inpatients during visiting hours and must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Labor & Delivery and Postpartum: 2 asymptomatic visitors may visit in the patient's room 24/7. Children of any age are allowed to visit, but they must be accompanied by an adult.
- NICU: For each patient, 2 asymptomatic designated parents/support persons may visit at the bedside 24/7. Children 12 years of age and older are allowed and must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Emergency Department: One (1) visitor is allowed when it is deemed safe by our staff. Due to the special care and treatment sometimes required, visitors may be asked to wait in the waiting area, or the number of visitors may be limited. Visitors in the patient care area are asked to always remain at the patient's bedside.
